*Allowable changes or substitutions must be presented by the coach no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the seeding meeting.
*No additions or substitutions can be made to relay lists after the List of Participants deadline

Competition Rules: All rules in the NFHS Track and Field Rule Book, IHSA Terms and Conditions, and IHSA Manual for Schools and Managers will be followed.

Games Committee: A Games Committee will be established during the Sectional Seeding Meeting according to the IHSA Terms and Conditions.

Competing Schools: Braidwood (Reed-Custer), Clinton, Coal City, Eureka, Fairbury (Prairie Central), Herscher, Lincoln, Mahomet (M.-Seymour), Manteno, Morris, Morton, Normal (University), Peotone, Pontiac, Rantoul, Stanford (Olympia)

Timing/Results: Timing will be provided by Pontiac Township High School using a Flash Timing System. Weather conditions on the day of the Sectional will determine the direction of the 110m Hurdles, 100m Dash, High Jump, Pole Vault, Long Jump, and Triple Jump. Regardless of direction, the FAT System will be used. Results will be posted on athletic.net at the conclusion of each event. Please notify the Meet Referee or Meet Manager if you believe there is an error in the results. Results will not be considered official until the conclusion of the meet.

Facility: Pontiac Township High School's track and field facility was renovated in the summer of 2023 and features a navy track with orange 4x100m exchange zones. Two long/triple jump runways can be run either north or south, with a single pole vault runway that can be run either east or west. Concrete Shot Put and Discus rings are located just behind the west bleachers.

Team Camps: No team camps on the football field. Tents may be set up in any of the grass areas outside the track.

Weigh-ins: Weigh-ins for the pole vault, shot put, and discus will be conducted at The Chop House

Changing Facilities: Teams should arrive to the facility dressed for competition. Restrooms are available near the entrance to the track and near the 100m Start line. Porta Potties are available near the finish line.

Meet Staging: Athletes will report to the clerk and be staged near the location of their starting line.

Warm-up/Track Use: Only competing athletes and coaches should be inside the fence/track area. All parents/spectators should remain outside of the fence. Once running events begin, warm-ups should be limited to the back stretch. Hurdles are located around the track and may be used but should be put back where they were found. Please use chalk to mark the track or runways. Chalk will be provided at field events and exchange zones. Tape will be removed.

Athletic Trainer: A certified athletic trainer will be available beginning at 3:30pm.

Parking: Buses may drop off at the entrance to the track and then park in the lot to the west of the Rec Center. Spectator parking will be available in the lot west of the school building after 3:00pm. Handicapped parking is available in the student lot or faculty lot.

Hospitality Room: Sub sandwiches, chips, and water will be available for coaches and workers in The Chop House after weigh-ins are complete.

Concessions: Concessions will be offered at The Chop House and proceeds support our Track team.

Awards: IHSA Sectional Champion Plaque will be awarded to the winning team at the conclusion of the meet at the common start/finish line.
Medals will be awarded to the top six (6) finishers in each event. Medals will be available in the press box at the conclusion of the meet.

Scoring: All individual and relay events will be scored 1st through 8th place. 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

Advancement:

First and second place winners in each event will advance to the State Finals. Additionally, any athletes who meet or exceed the 2025 qualifying standard will advance.

In the event of a tie, for both scoring and advancement purposes:

- Ties for running events will be broken per NFHS Rule 3-8-3
- Ties for High Jump and Pole Vault will be broken per NFHS Rule 6-3-2b
- Ties for Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put and Discus will be broken per NFHS Rule 6-3-2a

Weather:

Ordinary poor weather conditions will not stop the meet. In the case of extreme/severe weather conditions, Meet Management, the IHSA Officials and the Games Committee may adjust the time schedule.

In the event of extreme/severe weather, athletes and spectators will be instructed to return to vehicles. In the event shelter is needed, athletes and spectators will be instructed to move to areas in the pool or the high school locker rooms.


